

CSR Group Completes Valley National Bank in Rockville Center, NY

The CSR Group completes the restoration and renovations to the Rockville Center (Circa 1926) existing downtown building for Valley National Bank. The property known as 41 Front Street at the corner of Clinton Avenue was a former bank and was vacant for a number of years before Valley National Bank purchased the property to expand its presence in Long Island.

The existing building is approximately 15,482 gross square feet, two story plus cellar. It was constructed of masonry and steel frame. The building is of a Federal Style, with a historic limestone façade and flat roof with parapets and metal clad cornice. The first floor has ornate high bay plaster ceilings and decorative columns and piers. CSR Group designed and built the project and made full renovations including restorations of existing historical details. The existing vault was cleaned and being used by the bank. New electronic bank systems and upgraded customer service and teller configurations and were put in place and the drive-in was upgraded.

The Building will be occupied as a bank on the first and basement levels and tenant offices at the second floor.
